Community Outreach for Radical Empowerment (C.O.R.E.)	Behavioral Health Access for Underserved Young People	Support and expand C.O.R.E.'s Life Skills Support Program at their youth center for at-risk young people ages 29 and under. Includes addressing harm reduction needs and programming led by people with lived experience.
Network Charter School	Building a Policy of Equity and Inclusivity	Working with a local equity consultant, review and update all school policies and procedures to make school culture more inclusive, including offering workshops for students and families.
Grand Rising Unlimited	Grand Rising Unlimited Healing in Lane County	After-school and summer programs for youth empowerment and healthy habits for middle schoolers.
H.O.N.E.Y., Inc.	Journey to Holistic Wellness and Healing	Mindfulness activities to improve mental health in local elementary, middle, and high schools, including creation of a wellness ambassador program to create self-care, wellness, and anti-bullying leaders at all grade levels in schools.
