- b. Rhonda Busek gave Lane Community Health Council report and reported the website for Lane Community Health Council is now live. Lane Community Health Council continues to work with United Way and other community organizations around funding for COVID-19. PacificSource is continuing to assist members with needs and are answering 90% of calls within 30 seconds.
