

How to Apply

Thank you for your interest in the Lane Community Health Council's (LCHC) funding opportunities. Please read all eligibility requirements before proceeding to the online grant application. Our open funding cycle for FY2022 is focused specifically on five priority areas (listed below under Eligibility). Any proposal that does not specifically address one of these areas will not be considered.

Here is a quick overview of the application process:

- Review the LCHC eligibility criteria
- Become familiar with the priority area(s) your project impacts by reviewing the two LCHC priority areas and the three Lane Community Health Improvement Plan (<u>http://www.livehealthylane.org/chachp.html</u>) priority areas
- Complete application in online grant portal

- Review Committee evaluates project and determines approval or denial
- Review Committee submits recommended projects to the Community Impact Committee for approval
- Community Impact Committee submits the recommended projects to the Board of Directors for final approval
- Applicants will be notified of their application status by December 2022
- Awards will be distributed by December 2022

<u>Eligibility</u>

Please read all eligibility requirements thoroughly before proceeding.

- The applicant must be an organization with a tax identification number (EIN). We do not restrict funding based on organization type (non-profit, faith-based, government agency, etc.)
 - If you do not have an EIN, you will need to work with a fiscal sponsor to complete the application



- Projects must specifically impact Lane County.
- Projects must address **one or more** of the priority areas outlined below:
 - Lane Community Health Council Priority Areas:

 - Youth behavioral health
 - Behavioral health workforce
 - The 2021-2025 Lane County Community Health Improvement Plan (CHP) Priority Areas: <u>http://www.livehealthylane.org/chachp.html</u>
 - Ensure incomes are sufficient to meet basic costs of living (i.e., housing, childcare, food transportation, etc.)
 - Establish community conditions that support behavioral health and physical well-being
 - Address current historical injustices that produce disparities
- Priority will be given to projects that improve the social determinants of health and health equity (SDOH-E) of our community members. This includes:
 - Economic Stability
 - Neighborhood and Build Environment
 - o Education
 - Social and Community Health
 - Housing Supports and/ or Services
- Priority will be given to proposals that serve people or communities that experience health disparities
- Funding requests need to be between \$50,000 \$250,000
- To be considered for the full award amount (\$250,000), your project should address at least one of the SDOH-E area(s), a LCHC priority area AND a Community Health Improvement Plan priority area
